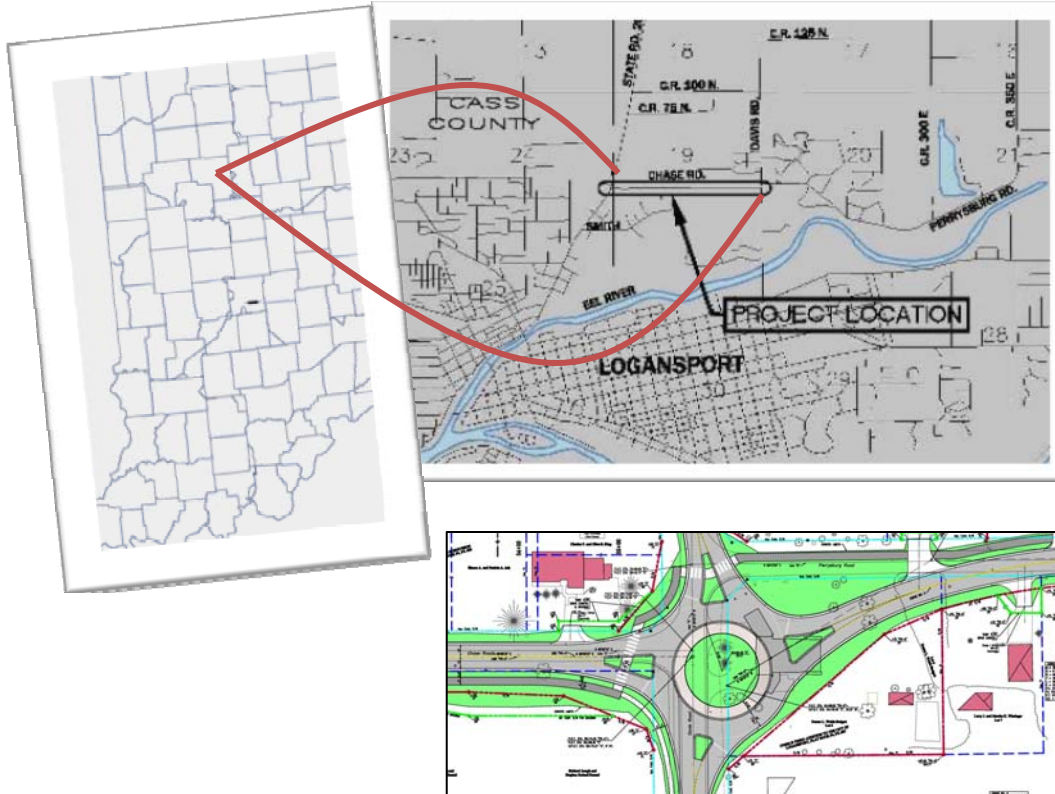

## Project Highlights

- This joint Cass County and City of Logansport Federal Aid project will reconstruct Chase Road from Michigan Ave (SR 25) with an urban cross section through the intersection of Davis Road. Chase Road is an urban collector bordered by residential, commercial, and agricultural land use within the project limits.
- Traffic safety and capacity will be improved by replacing the narrow 20' existing roadway with 12' travel lanes in each direction and adding a center turn lane through the western half of the project where substantial commercial development has occurred.
- The steep grade of Chase Road at Michigan Road will be decreased and a more level storage area will be provided for drivers waiting to turn onto the state highway.
- The existing offset intersection of Chase, Davis, and Perrysburg Roads will be replaced with a modern roundabout to improve safety and capacity. The roundabout will enhance the northern entryway to the city and its design accounts for large trucks that may use the roadway to access the nearby county fair grounds.
- The new roadway will have curb & gutter adjacent to the travel way to accommodate drainage with inlets and new storm sewer system. Two large cross culverts will be replaced.
- Right-of-way acquisition was minimized to 31 parcels. Utility impacts are minimized by shifting the proposed road centerline southward away from electric transmission lines in order to provide required safety clear zone.
- An 8' wide multi-use path proposed along the south side of Chase Road will connect existing sidewalks along Michigan Avenue and Davis Road to create a pedestrian loop encompassing award winning River Bluff Trail.
