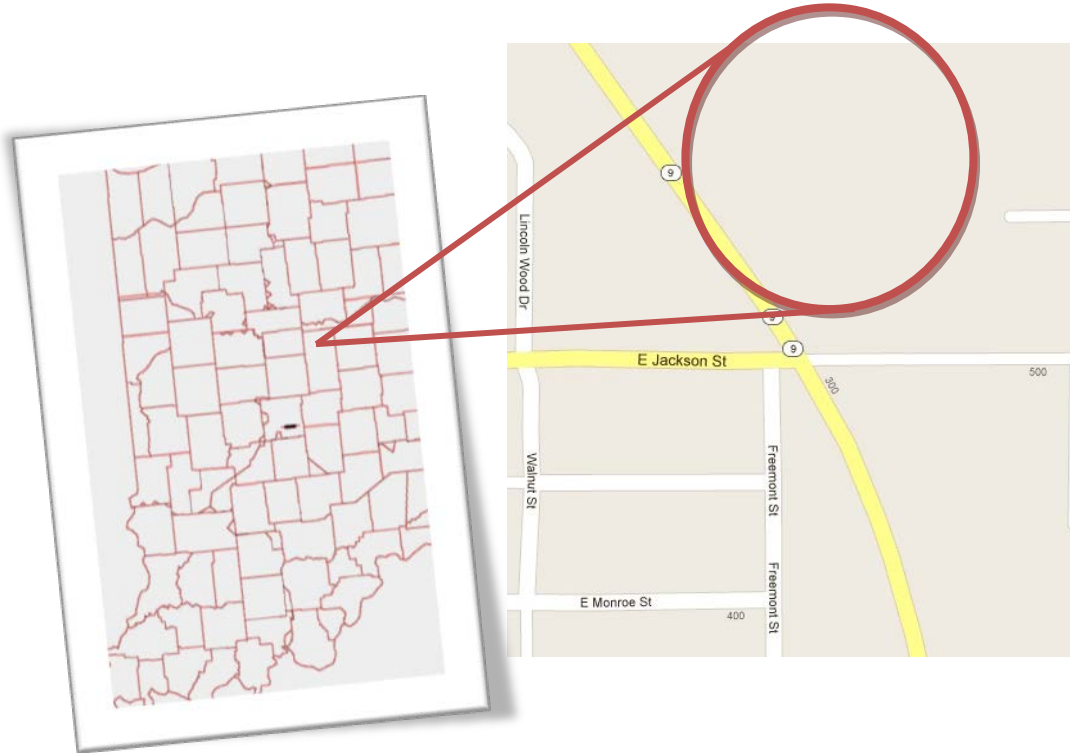


Dollar General

Project Highlights

- This project involved the development of a ±9,000 square feet, one-story building for a Dollar General retail store in Alexandria, Indiana.
- The storm water quantity and post-construction water quality requirements for the development are accomplished on site by a dry detention basin with a restrictive outlet control structure.
- The construction of the site also included a 565 lft extension of 6" water main to serve the development.
- Due to the presence of horizontal and vertical curves on SR 9 in the project vicinity, the design of the site included verification of stopping sight distance requirements for left and right turning movements exiting the development onto SR 9 per INDOT requirements.
