Project Highlights

- This project involved the development of a ±4,800 square feet, one-story building for a Gas America gas station / convenience center in Pendleton, Indiana. Also included, were the construction of public road improvements to SR 9 and SR 67, and installation of a frontage road and earthwork fill for a future out lot.
- The storm water quantity and quality requirements for the development were accomplished on site by an underground detention system of 55-Stormtech SC-740 chambers, with an Isolator Row and a restrictive outlet control structure. All storm water discharge from the gas station site is routed by a storm sewer network to the Isolator Row that treats for storm water quality.
- The construction of the site included a 10" water main jack and bore installation crossing SR 67, and installation of 12" water main across the entire frontage of the property.
