Project Highlights

- A combination of federal and local funding was utilized to rehabilitate and enhance this vital arterial corridor in the suburban area of north Indianapolis.
- Two of Carmel's first roundabouts were updated to today's design standards, and truck aprons were added to inner circle while maintaining existing landscape.
- A third roundabout was added to the corridor to alleviate congestion at a busy intersection.
